The camps of the Diocese of Manchester – Camp Fatima for boys and Camp Bernadette for girls – urge that all campers be covered by some form of personal medical or health insurance. The specifics regarding that insurance (name of carrier, address for bills, policy number, etc.) must be provided to the diocesan camp at the time of check in.

In the event of illness or injury requiring treatment, hospitalization, or surgery, the family medical insurance will be used, if available. Parents or guardians, or their insurer, will be billed directly by the provider for any medical care given at a local hospital, doctor's office, or clinic.

The diocesan camps provide accident insurance for all campers. However, medical benefits available to a camper through a family insurance policy are used first, before the camper accident insurance. Benefits under the camper accident insurance are available "first dollar" to any camper who does not have other medical coverage.
